TRIBUTE TO THE MISSILE MAN OF INDIA - JULY 26, 2023

Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam (15 October 1931 – 27 July 2015) was an Indian aerospace scientist and statesman, who served as the 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007. He is known as the 'Missile Man of India' for his contribution to developing India's missile projects, Prithvi and Agni missiles.



Remembering and honouring the great man on his death anniversary, the DIS Science Department organised a programme entitled 'Tribute to the Missile Man of India' on July 26, 2023. Students of Grade 11A and 11B started with a special assembly. Thereafter, some students of Grades 7, 8 and 11 masqueraded as famous personalities like Dr. A.P.J.
